

Last Will single-box foamcore insert

Introduction

This insert holds all the components for *Last Will* and *Last Will: Getting Sacked* by Czech Games Edition. It hides the original bidding board underneath the insert, assuming that players will want to use the variable board from *Getting Sacked*, but the insert works just as well with all boards kept on top. In order to minimize shifting during transport, one component is an optional lift that brings the top of the component layers in line with the top of the box. You can also hide the extra board and original game Last Will cards (which are not used in the expansion game) under the lift). All foamcore components are built with 5mm foamcore, and all measurements are given in Millimeters.

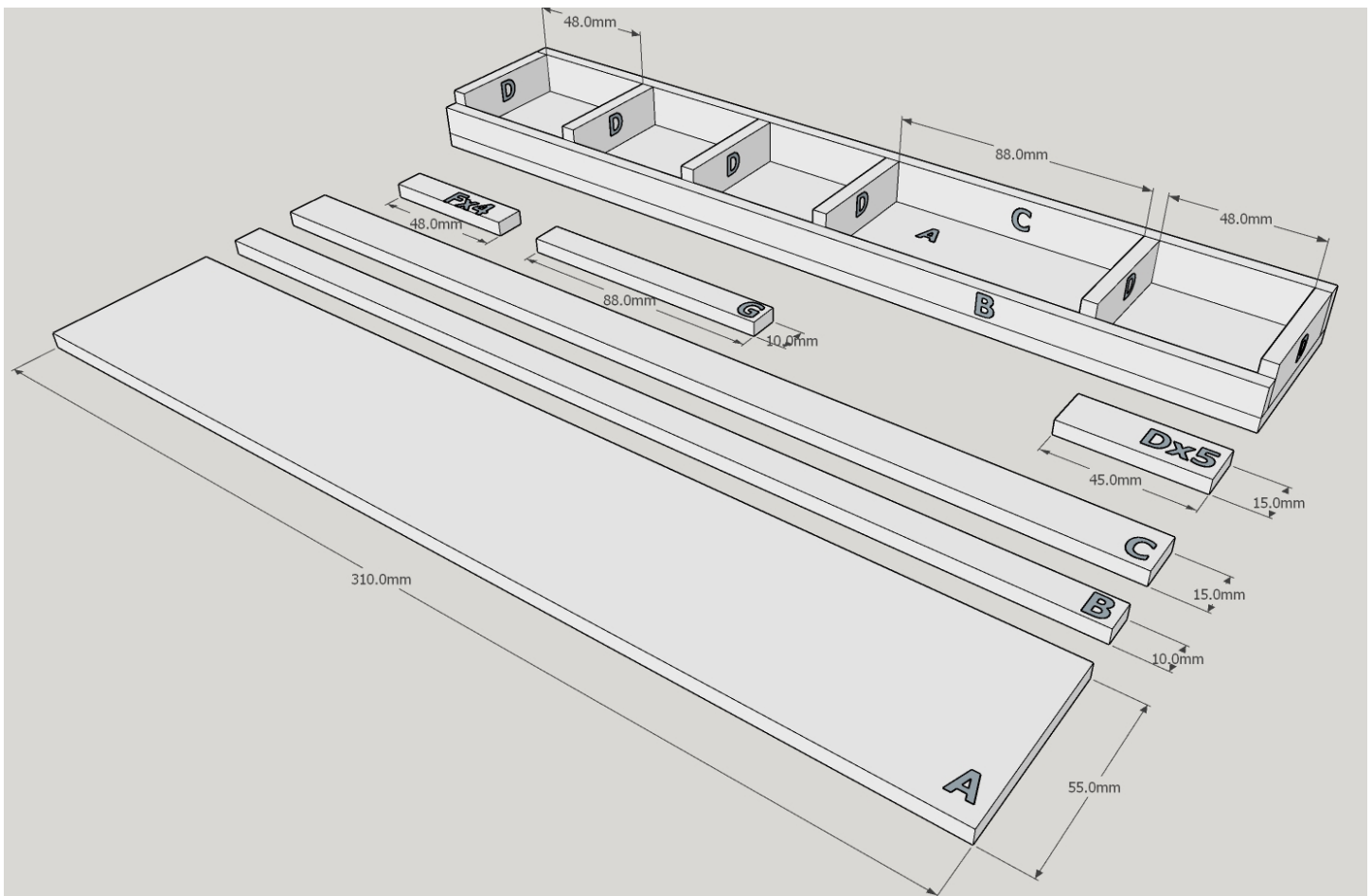
Components to build

- 2 card trays
- 1 money tray
- 1 player tray
- 1 token tray
- 1 lift (optional)

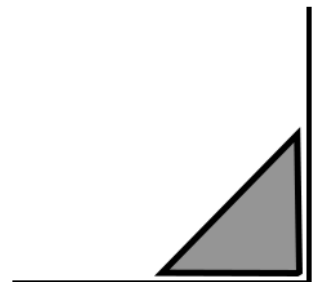
MONEY TRAY 1 – holds £1, £2, £5, £10, and £50 tiles.



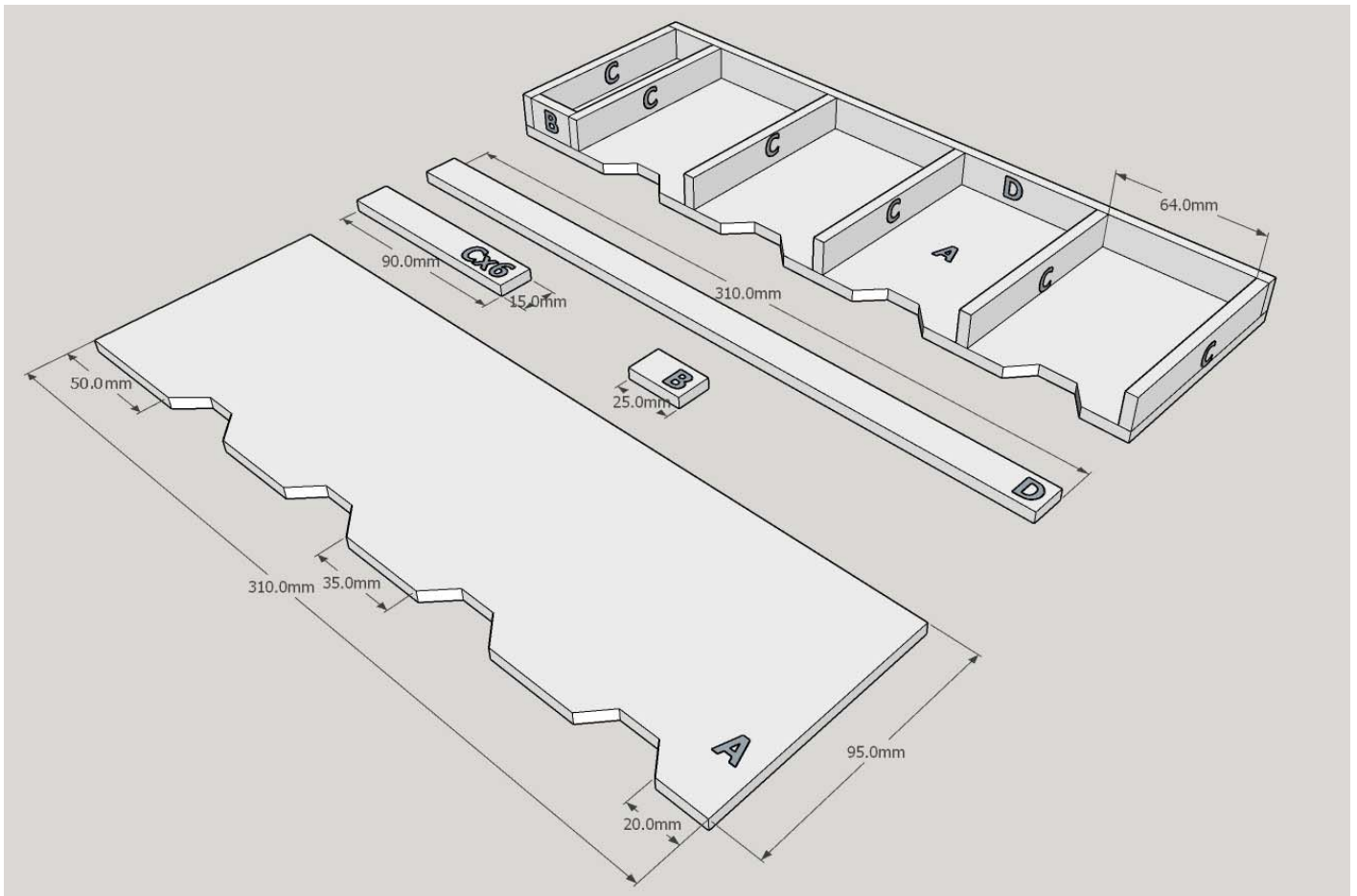
Parts F and G in this diagram are optional, and can be used to make “wedges” or “ramps” for the front end of each compartment so that money can be removed more easily. To make these wedges, cut the foam core to size, then cut each edge at an angle (as shown) and glue in the corner. This may take some practice, but it will make the tray much easier to use.

Note 1 - £10 tiles have a double-wide compartment

Note 2 – The prototype in the photo has a wider £50 tray. We recommend making the trays for £1, £2, £5, and £50 equal as in the diagram.

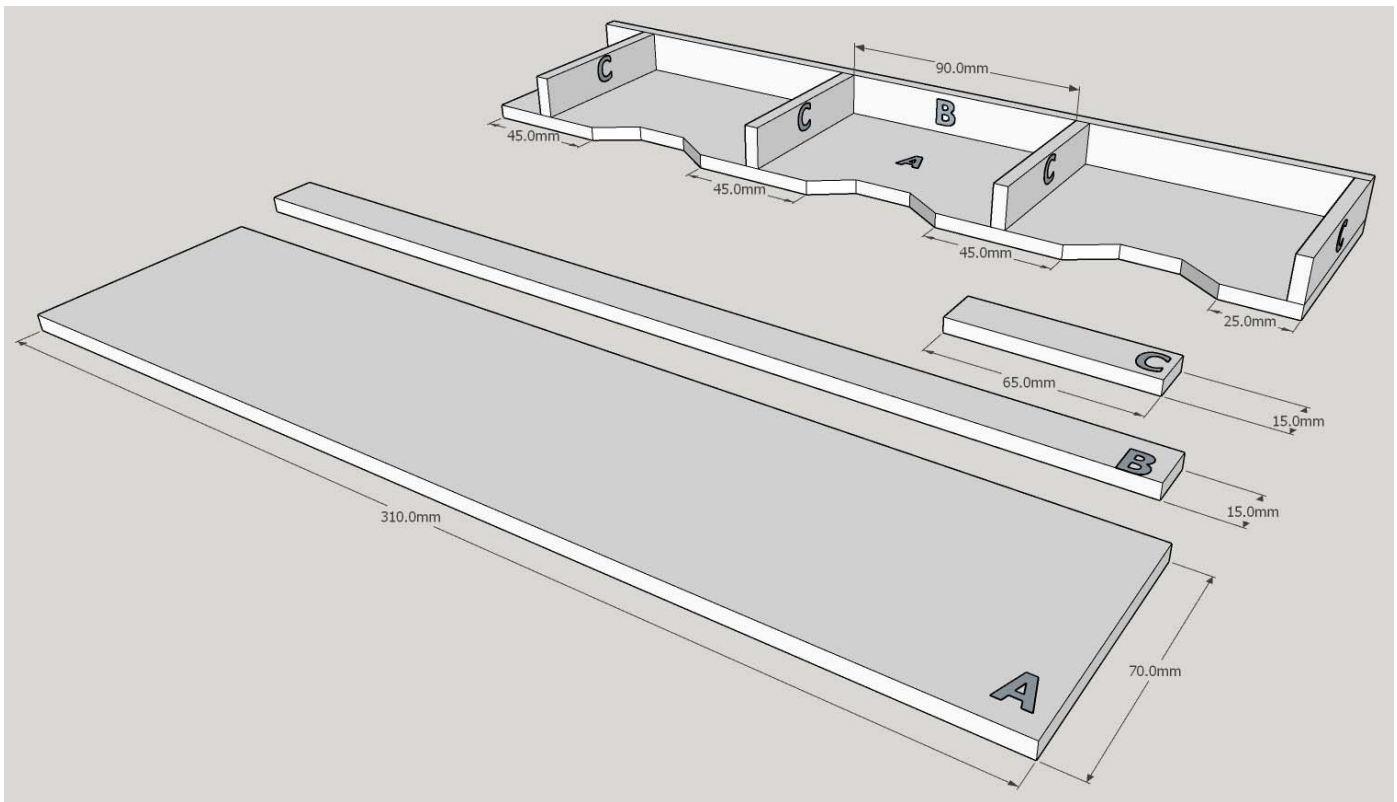


CARD TRAY 1 – holds employment tokens, friends and expenses, properties, events, and companions.



While the diagram shows the notches cut out ahead of time, I cut these out after I constructed the tray, ignoring precise measurements. You just need enough to get your finger under the deck.

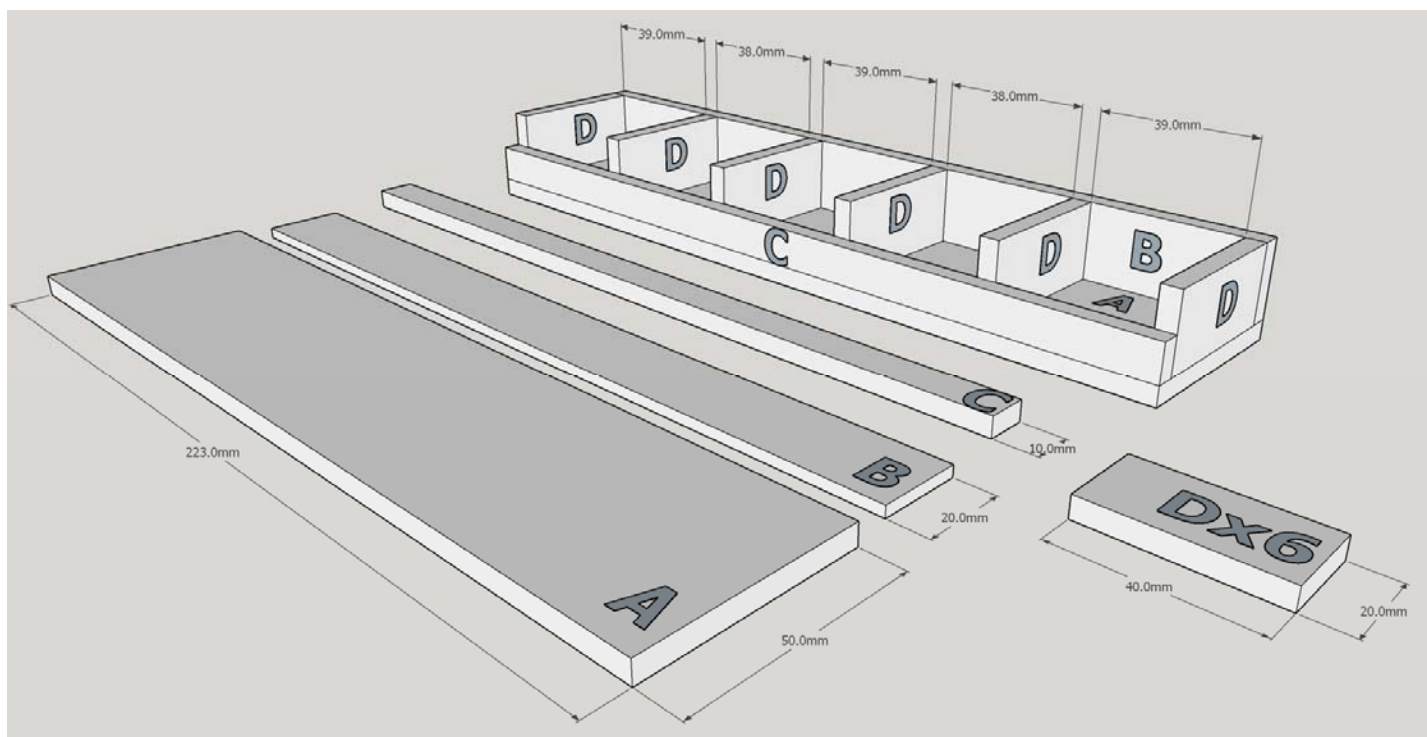
CARD TRAY 2 – store *Last Will and Wild Cards*; Store & displays Purple events, Red events, employment cards



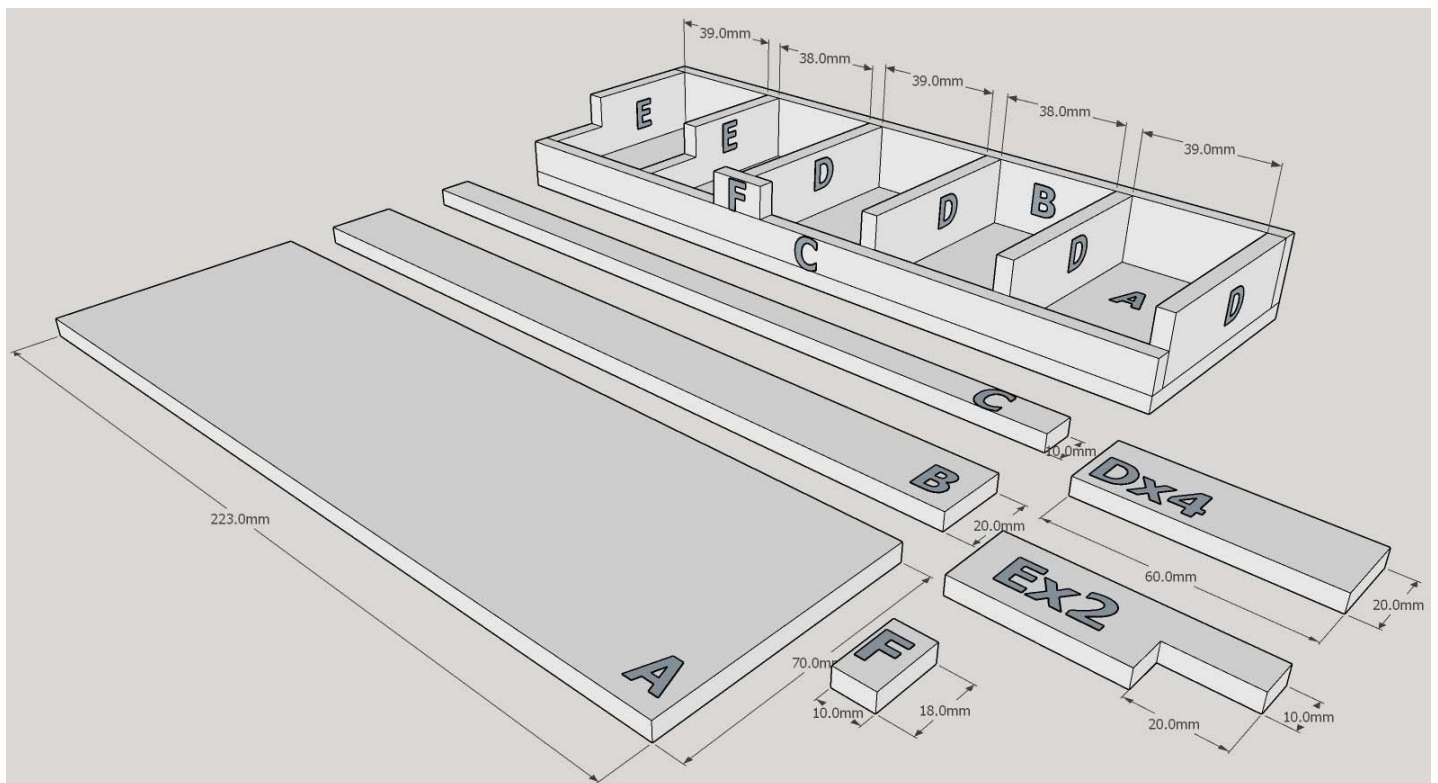
While the game is in storage, the last will cards and wild cards are on top of the job cards and the purple crown cards. This tray can be put next to the board, otherwise.

NOTE: The small spot on the end is there to keep the tray from sliding around in the box.

PLAYER TOKEN TRAY – holds individual player tokens, sorted by color

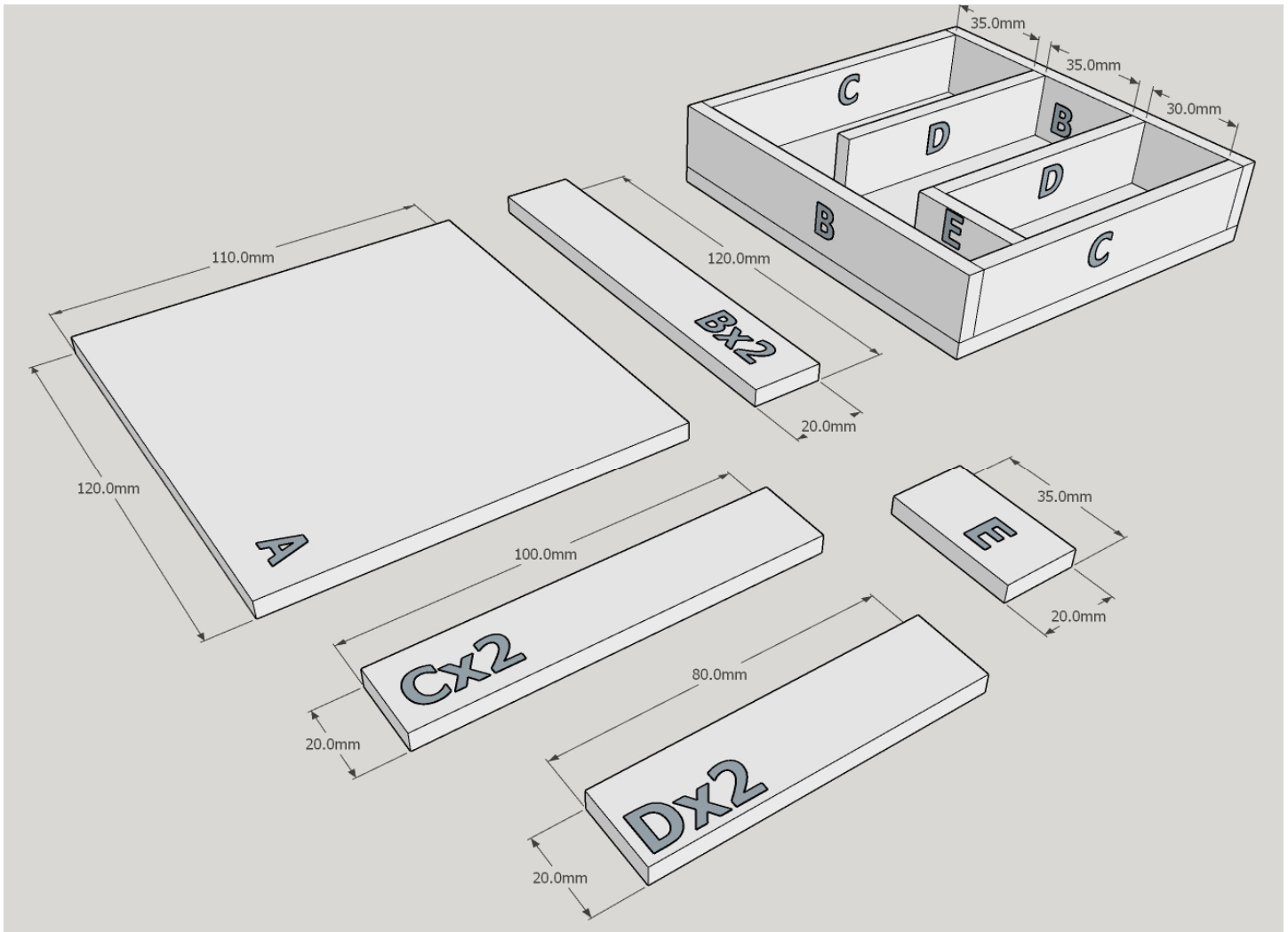


STATUS TOKEN TRAY – holds status tokens



NOTE: The notch and small support piece are there to keep the board extension from sliding around when the game is in storage. See Packing Instructions for details.

ACTION CARDS AND OTHER BITS – holds 2-3 player action cards, 4-5 player action cards, round marker, first player marker, real estate value tokens, and gray player action counter tokens

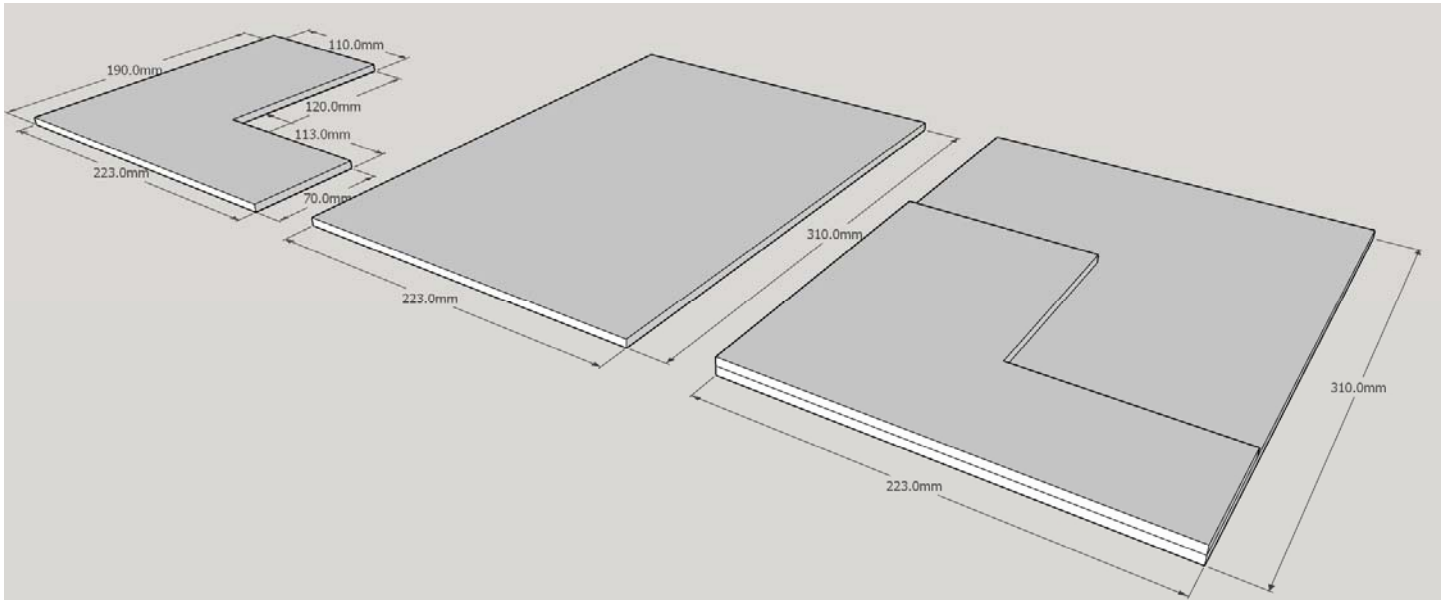


NOTE: Consider gluing a 2 or 3mm thick piece of scrap foam to the bottom of the action card storage area, about 75mm down from the top. This will make the cards lie slightly unevenly and make them easier to pick up. See photo for example.

NOTE 2: An alternative storage option is to put the gray discs with the player tokens, since each player gets one disc.

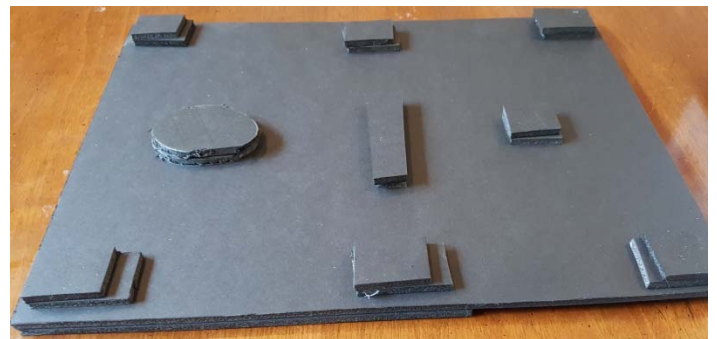


STORAGE LIFT – makes player boards and extra spaces even with layer two, lifts all components up to even with box top.
Also can be used to hide the unused action board and original game last will cards.



NOTE:

At a minimum, the L-shaped piece is needed to lift the player boards and extra card spaces. To make this full lift, create both pieces above, and then use scrap pieces, two-layers thick, to lift the setup. For an example of the fill-in section, see below. Of course, you could also just make three of the 223x310 pieces and stack them, but this solution works fine.



PACKING INSTRUCTIONS

1. In the empty box, put the old action board and the last will cards from the original game.



2. Next, put the component lift.
3. Next, put the extra action spaces and player boards on the L-shaped lift.



4. Put the player tokens along the end, then the status token tray.
5. Put the action card tray in the remaining space.
6. Finally, put the player board extension opposite the action card tray, using the cutout in the status token tray to secure it.



7. Place the special event card tray over the player extension boards.
8. Place the other card tray across from it.
9. Place the money token tray between the two.



10. Finally, place the action board, unfolded, the card selection boards, and the instructions on the top.
